## **Our Chapter Goals**

- Community Service: Organize at least one community service event per semester
- Academic Resources: Increase the number of resources in the test drive by 5% (325 -> 341)
- Professional Readiness: Host at least 2 career workshops per semester, with at least 1 being geared toward underclassmen


